now be argued (successfully) that the volunteers now have the nicest office of anyone, staff or otherwise!

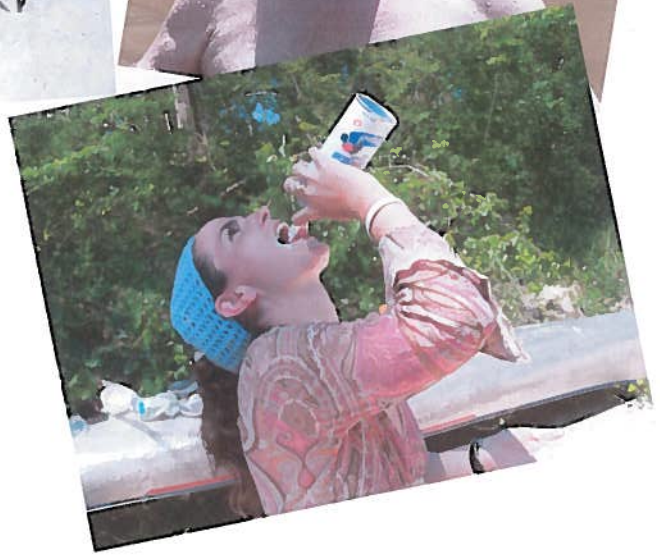
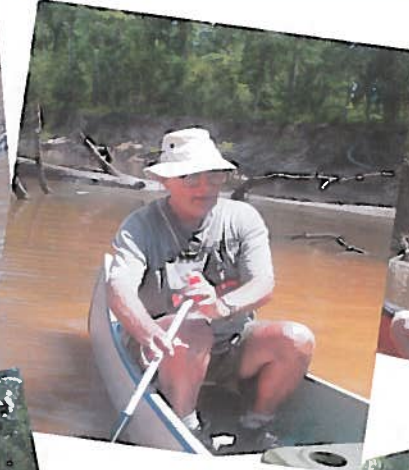
